1883 - 1908

These records were abstracted from a book located in the attic at the Mahoning County courthouse. They were first published, over a period of fourteen months, in our newsletter *Mahoning Meanderings*, starting in November, 1986, and ending in April, 1988.

The Coroners Inquest Book No. 1 contains records of those deaths that were investigated by the Coroner or his representative. These records start in January, 1883. For the most part they are investigations of deaths that occurred in the city of Youngstown. The city did not start recording deaths until January, 1892, so the deaths printed here are not recorded anywhere else (with a few exceptions).

The entries on the first two pages were neither alphabetical nor chronological. This indicates that they were gathered from other sources and entered here all at one time. Subsequent entries were in chronological order under the first letter of the surnames. For the benefit of the researcher, we have listed the names in alphabetical order, with a citation to the original page.

The information presented here is *all* that the book contains, except for the name of the Coroner or his representative. Ages and birth dates were not recorded in the original volume.

In rare cases the spelling of a name was changed when it was *known* to be incorrect. The age and condition of the book, and the poor handwriting, sometimes made it very difficult to decipher names. We have made every effort to make this compilation as error free as possible.

The data is in columns as follows:

If an - is used, it denotes a blank in the original record.

RUSH OVER CROSSINGS AHEAD OF LOCOMOTIVES AND TRAINS REGARDLESS OF GATES BEING DOWN

It is common occurrence for people to "roast" railroad men and charge them with all manner of evil intentions and downright indifference and carelessness. And every time anybody is killed or hurt on a railroad crossing one may hear all kinds of censure for the railroad men in general.

A Vindicator reporter who had business with the fireman of an Erie yard engine, boarded the engine at the Market Street crossing Saturday and rode up and down about 30 minutes while some switching was done. Neither the fireman nor engineer had time to talk then, but devoted their whole attention keeping track of the signals from the conductor and brakeman and looking out as much as possible to keep from running over people. Of all the fireman and engineer had to do, it is safe to say that the last mentioned task was the most difficult, and tended strongly to make their hair turn gray. The reporter held his breath several times for he felt sure for a moment or two that a man or woman who had started across the track ahead or behind the locomotive would surely be caught. The fact that the gates were down at the different crossings didn't appear to make any difference. No matter how close the locomotive was, many men and women would dodge under the gates and dart across the track. If any of them had slipped and lost their footing they would surely have been injured and perhaps killed, for in most cases it would have been impossible for the engineer to stop his locomotive within the few feet between the engine and the person when he would have fallen.

The reporter could not help remarking how many people appeared to have little or no consideration for the risk they took. The engineer was too busy but the fireman said; "If only we could get some of the people who are continually crying out against railroads and railroad men, to ride about on the locomotive a half day or a day, and see for themselves the utter carelessness of people who are supposed to know better. I think there would be a big revolution in sentiment. If he had the engine and tender covered with men they could not prevent people from running across the track when the locomotive or cars were approaching. Anybody can see that demonstrated for themselves, if they will take the trouble to look into the matter carefully. Some of the narrow escapes I see every day give me the headache. I know of one man who will be killed or crippled sooner or later. I have come within an ace of catching him several times on crossings and there will come a time when there will be a miss and he will be caught. He pays no attention to the gates, but goes right under the arm and bolts over the track without looking up. Sometime he will slip and fall, or a locomotive or car will be too close and that'll be the last of him, and though it will be the fault of no one but himself the railroad company will have to suffer. There are plenty more like him, and those are the people who worry engineers and firemen half to death."

When the reporter had ridden for half an hour he saw for himself that every word the fireman had said was the truth, and that he could have told much more that was just as true and even more startling.

This article appeared in the *Youngstown Vindicator*, Sunday, 12 Dec 1897 and explains why the Coroner's Inquests list so many people "killed by cars" or "hit by engine," etc.

The "Market Street Crossing" was used before the 'high bridge' was built. Market Street went down to the North side of the Mahoning River where a small bridge crossed the river to the South side. On the South side was a high steep bank which had to be climbed to reach the street above.
