

MINISTERS LICENSE RECORDS

Mahoning County, Ohio

In Ohio, marriage laws required clergymen officiating at weddings to be licensed in the county where the ceremony was solemnized. Therefore clergymen applied for a license to perform marriages in Mahoning County, even though they were not residents of the county. He may have performed that one ceremony, then went back home.

Those page numbers in [brackets] are from: **MINISTERS LICENSE RECORD 1874 - 1900 MAHONING COUNTY.**

This docket covers licenses dated from 28 Sep 1870 through 28 Feb 1900 and there is one entry on each page. Those with no county name denote licenses that were originally granted in Mahoning County. Those with two dates include the date they received a license in the named county and the second date is the date they were granted one in Mahoning Co.

Those page numbers without brackets are from: **MINISTERS LICENSE RECORD 1 MAHONING COUNTY.**

This docket covers licenses dated from 21 Nov 1870 through 23 Dec 1919 and there are two entries on each page. Page 134 has only one entry and pages 135 through 139 were not used. This docket was used just for licenses originally granted in Mahoning County and the clergymen involved probably had congregations here.

Known errors in spelling were noted by the use of (sic).
