

The Loveland Farm Cemetery

Was located in Coitsville Township off Loveland Road., now on the south side, in the City of Youngstown at 3333 Loveland Road. Some parts of the tombstones were stored in a barn, the present owners of the land have lived there since the 1940's. Mahoning County Deed Records Vol. 142, page 533: Quit Claim deed from heirs of David Loveland 30 November 1908 for 1.8 acers. To purchase a burial plot in Poland – disinterred bodies.

The following inscriptions were copied 9 August 1905 by Henry R. Baldwin

Amos Loveland Born - August 1762 in N. H. Died - December 30, 1851

(Revolutionary War 2nd Conn. Regiment 1780)

Jemima Loveland Born – 1763 Died - 3 March 1855 Aged 92 years 11 months

Wife of Amos

Cynthia Loveland Born – 1798 Died - 16 September 1815 17 years

Daughter of Amos

Elizabeth Loveland partial stone
