

THE MAN ON THE MONUMENT

The "Man on the Monument" on Central Square in downtown Youngstown, Ohio, is a familiar landmark to those of us who live in the area.

The information on the monument was transcribed by William T. Powers and published in *Mahoning Meanderings*, the newsletter of The Mahoning Company Chapter of OGS. Volume 9, Issue # 2, pages 8 and 9.

The soldier's name is listed first, with the information on the monument. Then, in the paragraph below, we added what we were able to find on each soldier in the "**American Civil War Database**" at <http://www.civilwardata.com/>. You must be a member to access the database, but it is well worth the nominal fee charged.

Stone River is really Stones River, Georgia.

Please note: It is up to the individual researcher to solve the discrepancies between the information on the monument and that contained in the "Roster."

We have used the following abbreviations:

Cpl. - Corporal

HDS - Historical Data Systems.

Lt. - Lieutenant

OVC - Ohio Volunteer Cavalry

Sgt. - Sergeant

OVI - Ohio Volunteer Infantry

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The base of the monument [the side facing north] reads:

"ERECTED BY THE CITIZENS OF YOUNGSTOWN IN MEMORY OF THE HEROES OF THE TOWNSHIP WHO GAVE THEIR LIVES TO THEIR COUNTRY IN THE WAR OF THE REBELLION, 1861 - 1865."

On the four sides are the names of those who died in battle or died from disease contracted in the service.

Shannon, Thomas J., First Infantry Division, Army of Virginia. Surgeon-in-Chief, Cedar Creek. Residence was not listed; Enlisted on 7/22/1863 as a Surgeon. On 7/22/1863 he was commissioned into Field & Staff Ohio 116th Infantry. He died of wounds on 10/20/1864 at Cedar Creek, Virginia. He was listed as: * Wounded 10/19/1864 Cedar Creek, Virginia.. Truesdale, Joseph A., Second Ohio Volunteer Cavalry. Fort Scott

Residence was not listed; 18 years old. Enlisted on 8/10/1861 as a Private. On 10/30/1861 he mustered into "E" Company Second Cavalry. He died of disease on 8/5/1862 at Fort Scott, Kansas. Sources used by HDS: - Official Roster of the Soldiers of the State of Ohio - Roll of Honor of Ohio Soldiers.

Wakefield, William - Second Ohio Volunteer Cavalry. Washington.

Residence was not listed; 22 years old. Enlisted on 8/10/1861 as a Wagoner. On 10/30/1861 he mustered into "E" Company Ohio Second Cavalry. He died of wounds on 6/4/1865 at Washington, D C He was listed as: * Wounded 3/31/1865 Dinwiddie Court House, Virginia (Severely wounded in left leg, amputated). Kelley, Sgt. Andrew J. - Seventh Ohio Volunteer Infantry. Winchester, Virginia.

Deeds, Joseph P. [Joseph B.] - Seventh Ohio Volunteer Infantry. Dallas, Georgia.

Residence was not listed; 21 years old. Enlisted on 6/19/1861 as a Private. On 6/19/1861 he mustered into "I" Company Ohio Seventh Infantry. He died of wounds on 6/13/1864 at Chattanooga, Tennessee He was listed as: * Wounded 5/25/1864 Dallas, Georgia.
